

Mrs. Lebet's Class Supply List- 2015

For September, please bring in:

- 3- 2-pocket folder for homework, recorder...
- 1- Marble Composition Book- Wide Ruled (college ruled is too small)
- 3- three-ring binder (1 ½" or 2") with pockets (no trappers/zippers)
- Crayons (put name on box)
- Colored pencils (put name on box)
- Fine Tip Markers (put name on box)
- #2 Ticonderoga pencils - 1 box
- 1 Glue stick
- 1 pair of scissors (child safe)
- 2 Black Fine Tip Expo Markers (for slate boards)
- 2 Highlighters
- Post-Its
- Pencil sharpener with canister (put name on it)
- 2 boxes of tissues unless your child has allergies, then the more the merrier
- Plastic Pencil Box (put name on box)
- 1 container baby-wipes (our new room does not have a sink)
- Old adult T-shirt as an Art smock with NAME for specials in a zip lock bag

If your child will be mainstreamed for any content area, it would be helpful to have a soft pencil case with pencils, erasers, colored pencils, and crayons. Also, an additional 2-pocket folder to have when they join the gen ed. class. This can be coordinated in the few first weeks of school if you are unsure.

Your child will need the following supplies at home in order to complete homework assignments.

- Glue
- Pencils only
- Crayons
- Erasers
- Scissors
- Ruler

It is helpful to set up a homework box with these supplies, a folder to keep resource materials (like 100 grid, TouchMath Number Line), and to establish a homework routine for completing homework and reading logs.
