The Central School Positive Behavior System	Classroom	Restroom	Hallway	Cafeteria	Playground
Respect Yourself	Show self-control and alertness.	Wash your hands after using the bathroom.	Walk safely and be aware.	Stay seated.	Be safe.
Respect Others	Avoid distracting others so they can learn.	Respect other students' privacy.	Walk quietly.	Don't touch other people's food. Give classmates personal space.	Listen to your lunch aide. Include other people in games.
Respect Property	Treat books, desks, and other equipment with care.	Flush toilet after use. Throw paper towels in wastebasket.	Don't touch work that is hanging on the walls.	Clean up after yourself.	Use equipment as it was designed.
